Tinicum Township Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes March 1, 2022

Supervisors Eleanor Breslin, Jim Helms and Richard Rosamilia were present with Township Manager Teri Lewis and Township Solicitor Steve Harris. The meeting was held in the Tinicum Township building meeting room. There were 11 people in attendance.

Chairperson Rosamilia called the public meeting of the Tinicum Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:30 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A. Public Comment

Cindi Gasparre, River Road, asked the following:

- If there is a way to enforce the speed limit on River Road now that it will be lowered to 25 miles an hour. Helms said that the only method available to Pennsylvania municipalities is to place lines on the road and time the cars. Helms suggested that people contact to their state reps and ask them to pass the House Bill that would allow municipalities to use radar.
- If the police could issue warnings. Rosamilia said that was a good idea and they would talk to Chief Madden at the next meeting about giving out warnings.
- If the Board had made a decision to enact a Road Safety Advisory. Rosamilia said they were putting together list of pros and cons and then they would be discussing it with Public Works and Chief Madden.
- If the Board had made a decision on remote access to Supervisor meetings. Rosamilia said it was still under discussion. Helms said they were also looking into the technical aspect of live stream. Lewis said that the current speed of the Township internet was not fast enough.

Rick Balukas, River Road, asked if the Board of Supervisor Work Sessions would open and interactive with the public. Rosamilia is the work sessions are always open to the public. He said he did not know why the work session would be any different from regular meetings.

Vladimir Salamun, Headquarters Road, asked if the Board would be announcing the Work Session topics. Rosamilia stated that the agenda is posted online the day before.

Jessee Salamun, Headquarters Road, asked how someone could get something added to the work session. She said that she wanted to add removing trees from creeks on the work session agenda. Helms said that it would be brought up at the current regular meeting. Rosamilia said they would look at that topic and decide if the Board wanted to put it on the work session agenda. He said that work session agenda requests should be submitted to the Township Manager, Teri Lewis. Rosamilia said Lewis would forward the request to the Board and then they would decide.

B. New Business

Lower Delaware Wild & Scenic River 2022 Mini-Grant Agreement.

Breslin said that in January they had submitted an application to the Lower Delaware Wild & Scenic River 2022 Mini-Grant Program for a Rain Barrel Workshop to be held in the Township. She said the workshop has received funding.

Motion: to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 PM.


